Camp Survive (Big Sandy Lake) is a 5-day junior high camp open to students who have completed grades 6-8. Activities at camp include talks, music, daily Mass, Reconciliation, Adoration, games, swimming, archery, laser tag, survival training, and more!!! The registration fee includes all meals, a t-shirt, and lodging in cabins.

Registration Fee: \$295 (registration increases \$20 after July 12, 2019 and camp fills up quickly, so register early!) A \$50 deposit is due at the time of registration. All payments are due by July 19, 2019.

Open to: Students who are in Grades 6-8 this school year (2018/2019) and who live in the Diocese of Duluth. We are not able to take non-diocesan students because of the popularity of this event. We always fill up and have a waiting list with students from our own diocese. WOMEN'S COUNCIL OF ST EDWARD'S MISSION MINISTRY

The Women's Council of St Edward's is continuing their mission ministry. We hope that you, the parishioners, will again be on board with us. You have been so generous in the past and we thank you. Kits will be put together again for the Global Health Ministry, a non-profit, faith-based charitable organization devoted to health care globally.

Newborn kits and hospice kits will be assembled. They will be delivered to GHM in Minneapolis for shipment to developing third world countries. Last year we delivered 34 newborn kits and 27 hospice kits to GHM. We also sent 4 boxes of miscellaneous items to the Cheyenne River Catholic Parishes in and around Eagle Butte, SD.

The newborn kits help with safe baby deliveries. The mothers are educated on pre-natal care, nutrition and immunizations for the baby. As a result baby fatalities have dropped dramatically. More of them are going to clinics for the baby's birth. As a result of the diapers that are included in the kits and sanitation education some of the mothers are now using diapers and even making their own.

The hospice kits are delivered to the homes of cancer and HIV/AIDS patients by a church volunteer or a Christian medical professional. The items in the kits help with the patients' home health care.

There is a list on the reverse side of this for all the supplies needed. Donations are needed. These may be left in the Holy Family room. Items not donated will be purchased. Monetary donations may be put in an envelope marked "missions" and dropped in the Church collection basket. Either way, we hope you will be as enthused as we are about these kits.
