Our Lady of the Lakes Magnificat continues to celebrate our 30th anniversary of ministry in the Duluth Diocese on October 8, 2022 by inviting Bishop Daniel Felton to share his testimony of his life with Jesus and the Holy Spirit at St. Agnes Parish in Walker, Mn

Bishop Felton comes from a family who owned the Valley Glass Company in Appleton, Wi. for three generations. Bishop Felton along with his grandfather and father are glaziers by trade. The beautiful coat of arms reveals the rich heritage of Bishop Felton. The lily of St. Joseph in the upper right corner is very special because Bishop Felton was ordained in the Year of St. Joseph and he has a special devotion to St. Joseph, especially the tradition of the "sleeping St. Joseph." Many a prayer intention has been placed under his statue of St. Joseph, where Bishop Felton knows that St. Joseph is working it out in his dreams. The waves on the coat of arms reminds one that Bishop Felton's appointments have always been along a body of water, Lake Winnebago, Lake Michigan, the Fox River, Green Bay and now Lake Superior. These waters have given Bishop Felton moments of prayer and rebirth reflective of the life-giving water of Jesus Christ.

Bishop Felton also has a special devotion to Our Lady Undoer of Knots. With the many challenges he faces, she is the perfect intercessor to undo the knots placed before him so that all may grow closer to Jesus.

Bishop Felton's favorite Scripture is "The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent. Believe in the Gospel." [Mark 1:15]

Bishop Felton's message to us is that Jesus Christ lived, died, and rose to new life and resurrection! To be disciples of Jesus we must have an encounter with him that opens us to discover, follow, and worship him. To make disciples we must have our own hearts set on fire in the love of the Holy Spirit, have found the abundance of life in Jesus and the Eucharist, and have been commissioned by the Father to go out to others and give witness in the Holy Spirit to Jesus Christ as our Lord and Savior. That is what it means not only to be a disciple in the Lord, but to make disciples for the Lord.
