Happy Mother's Day!

The Pregnancy Support Center here in Walker would like to invite you to join in our Baby Bottle Campaign from Mother's

Day to Father's Day. The money that we raise from our Bay Bottles supplies our Incentive Room with Strollers, car seats, cribs, bouncers, and any other baby gear that our clients need. They earn these items through educational modules that they complete on-line, and in-house.

Each year over 1.4 million babies lose their life to abortion. One in four women have experienced abortion, and are in need of healing from a decision often made through coercion, out of fear, lack of resources, or incomplete information.

This is our 13th year of working in our community to provide men and women with accurate medical information regarding pregnancy health, development of the unborn, pregnancy decision counseling, and life affirming alternatives to abortion. We also are able to encourage women who have experienced pregnancy loss or are experiencing adverse feelings after an abortion.

Our resources include, pregnancy testing, Maternity and baby clothing, Incentive Program for moms and dads, Sexual integrity classes, Bible Study, and referrals to other Community Help Programs.

The Incentive Program for moms and dads is the program funded by this Baby Bottle Campaign.

I encourage you to pick up a baby bottle, and fill it over the next few weeks with your change...(and of course bills or a checks) to help fund this program.

A Bottle holds about \$60 in quarters or dimes, and mixed change about \$25-30.

If you would like a receipt, please put a note in the bottle with your name, address and email address.

Thank you to all who have contributed to the Pregnancy Support Center in the past and for your continued faithfulness to the men and women we serve.

Road Construction in Longville

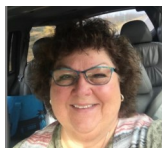
